# KNOWLTON ACADEMY ATHLETICS SKI PROGRAM 2014-2015

Good day,

You can bet that snow will soon cover the ground for good, so it's time to talk skiing! I'm happy to say that Knowlton Academy students will again have their annual Ski Program as part of their Physical Education course in January and February 2015. On this **45**<sup>TH</sup> edition, we will make our way to **Mont Sutton (montsutton.com)**. As usual, **ski instructors** will be hired to teach skiing skills to children (volunteers too!) Below is some key information about the program:

# WHO?

• Children from Grade 1 to Secondary 1 are to take part in the Ski Program; this **activity is compulsory** and is part of the Physical Education curriculum at K.A. and generates marks for Term 3.

### WHAT?

• Ski equipment (boots, skis, poles) will be provided by the school free of charge for students who need it; adult/parent volunteers will supervise small groups (1 adult for 3 children in grade 1/ beginner; up to 8 for more experienced skiers) for the entire day, and will cover the mountain code of conduct as well as some basic skills and maneuvers on skis. Each student will benefit from 90 minutes of instruction a day with a qualified CSIA ski instructor and receive an evaluation/certification at the end of the 5 days.

## **FYI**

- Children MUST wear a properly fitted ski helmet and we strongly encourage adult volunteers to wear one too.
- Students who wish to use their own ski equipment may do so providing they can get it to school/hill and back home for every ski day (NO SKI EQUIPMENT ON BUSES).
- Students are expected to be dressed for cold weather, have appropriate clothing and have a ski helmet.
- To keep feet warm and comfortable, we encourage students to wear **ski socks**: they must be **knee high** and you must absolutely AVOID COTTON! A good time to get them is during after Xmas specials in sports shops where ski equipment is sold.
- Children need to pack a **healthy lunch** for the day to keep their energy level optimal and fuel body heat!!! This year, the **K.A. cafeteria will prepare healthy lunch bags** that will include a sandwich, a fruit, a snack, a cookie and a drink, all for \$5.00/day. Orders to be done in the morning, on a ski day. Note that children will not have access to fried foods/ junk food in the main cafeteria at the hill.
- Children who wish to stay until the end of the ski day must make transportation arrangements and have a SIGNED NOTE FROM PARENTS AS THEY WILL BE UNSUPERVISED once we leave at 14h00. Please note that school equipment must be returned to school at the end of the ski day, no later than 17h00.

#### **RENT K.A. SKI EQUIPMENT!**

"KA Families" can rent ski equipment from the school; to reserve and make an appointment to pick it up, just write a note or send an e-mail to N. Lemaître. Skis can be taken out from Friday to Monday inclusively and during holidays for the entire ski season. **All proceeds are reinvested in our ski room**.

- \$10/set for a weekend or an evening;
- \$25/set for long holidays (Xmas, March Break and Easter).
- \$75/set: season rental (ALL weekends and holidays during winter).

# EACH CHILD WHO MEETS THE DEADLINE WILL EARN A CHANCE AT A DRAW: WIN YOUR FEES! ONE WINNER PER CYCLE AND ONE IN SEC. 1

This fee covers transportation from school to Mont Sutton and back along with a **full day** lift ticket (good until 16h00) and a 90 minute lesson. In an effort to save time and simplifying the management of fees, **payment must be made in full, NO LATER than January 16<sup>th</sup>**, **2015**, in one of two ways:

- 1. One lump sum, PREFERABLY BY CHEQUE, to <u>Knowlton Academy Ski Program</u>, for 5 days of skiing (<u>see table below</u>);
- 2. 5 post-dated cheques corresponding to each of the ski days (see previous table for dates, and the table below for the amount that applies);

Families with special circumstances who may need financial assistance to pay Ski Program Fees should contact the school secretary, Brenda Scott, in writing or by phone to make arrangements (payment plan). Do this before December 16<sup>th</sup> and your child will earn a chance at the draw.

#### **Procedure:**

- Please write your children' **FULL NAME & homeroom** on the cheques to help us keep track of fees. Ex; Mary Jones(2M), Johnny Jones(4L) and Bill Jones(6M)
- A student who misses a ski day due to a **serious illness** or any other event deemed valid by the Principal may get a refund providing a **written request is made <u>before</u> March 13th, 2015**;
- All **refunds** for the above-mentioned items will be **issued after March 13**<sup>th</sup>, **2015**, once the Ski program is over and the request deadline has gone by.

<sup>\*</sup>Because KA benefits from group rates for lift tickets, transportation and lessons, all students must pay their fee even if they hold a season's pass and/or have transportation to Mont Sutton to take part in the KA Ski Program.

# To Ski or Not to Ski: That is the question!

If you are uncertain if a ski day is on or not, you can:

- Consult the Kowlton Academy website after 7h00 and look for a message on the main page saying the ski day is cancelled. No specific message = we are skiing.
- Call the Mont Sutton Snow School after 7h00 at 450-538- 2545 #231

We will only cancel in case of extreme weather conditions. if the ski hill or school is closed. Note that the weather and temperature can vary greatly between Knowlton and Mont Sutton.

# COME SEE WHAT THIS IS ALL ABOUT; GET INVOLVED!

**VOLUNTEERS...** are the back-bone of the KA Ski Program and are one of the reasons it has lasted for some **45 YEARS**. This year is no different. There are many tasks that we need help with: supervision in the ski lodge, transportation of ski equipment and of course skiers of all levels who will supervise and do a little teaching (technique and safety) just to name a few!

- Adult volunteer skiers who can take a group of students (maximum of 10) get a free lift ticket for the **full day**. For the sake of management and consistency, priority will be given to skiers who can commit to 5 Tuesdays, 5 Thursdays or both. Keep in mind that a ski instructor will work with you and your group for 90 minutes a day!
- Volunteer skiers are strongly urged to take part in a two-part ski workshop;
- 1. The first part (indoor) will take place at Knowlton Academy on **Wednesday January 21st, 2015** in the Home Ec. room **from 18h30 to 20h30**. We will view a short video and discuss topics such as the objectives of the ski program, safety issues to cover and review with students, procedures on how to lead and organize a group of skiers on the mountain, teaching tips and techniques (<u>all parents and Staff welcome</u>).

2. The second part (outdoor) will be given on **Friday January 23rd, 2015 at Mont Sutton**. We will meet at the Snow School Desk at **12h30**, next to the ticket counter\*. We will be **skiing until 15h30**. We will put in action topics discussed in the "indoor session". This will also be a chance for skiers to get to know the mountain and the facilities and also to cover some technical points on ski teaching and try some skills & exercises to use with students. Time providing, some ski improvement may also be included for participants. \*Lift tickets provided free of charge by the Mont Sutton Snow School to pre-registered participants only.
